REGISTER ONLINE TO VOTE

North Carolina offers online voter registration on the NC DMV website: ncdot.gov/dmv

You will need:

- A North Carolina driver's license or DMV-issued ID number AND a social security number
- If you don't have these, you can still register by mail to vote on the NC Board of Elections website: votebyemail.ncsbe.gov

You can register online to vote until Friday, October 9, 2020.

HOW TO REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT

Fill out an official "**State Absentee Ballot Request Form**"

- You can pick one up at your county board of elections office, download a copy from NCSBE.gov OR request a ballot from votebyemail.ncsbe.gov

Return your completed "State Absentee Ballot Request Form" to your county board of elections office

- You can submit your form by fax, email, mail OR drop it off in-person

DEADLINE: Your absentee ballot request must be received in the county board of elections office by **October 27, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.**
