REGISTER ONLINE TO VOTE

- North Carolina offers online voter registration on the NC DMV website: ncdot.gov/dmv
- You will need:
 - A North Carolina driver's license or DMV-issued ID number AND a social security number
 - If you don't have these, you can still register by mail to vote on the NC Board of Elections website: votebyemail.ncsbe.gov
- You can register online to vote until Friday, October 9, 2020.



IMPORTANT DATES

September 1	Absentee Ballots start being mailed
October 9	Voter Registration Deadline
October 15	Early Voting Starts
October 27	Deadline to request absentee ballots
October 31	Last day of Early Voting
November 3	Election Day



HOW TO REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT

- Fill out an official "**State Absentee Ballot Request Form**"
 - You can pick one up at your county board of elections office, download a copy from NCSBE.gov OR request a ballot from votebyemail.ncsbe.gov
- Return your completed "State Absentee Ballot Request Form" to your county board of elections office
 - You can submit your form by fax, email, mail OR drop it off in-person
- DEADLINE:** Your absentee ballot request must be received in the county board of elections office by **October 27, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.**
